REDLAND CITY CHOIR CODE OF CONDUCT



The Redland City Choir is a diverse community choir where everyone, no matter their abilities, is encouraged to contribute their best. It is the responsibility of members to uphold the high standard and good reputation of the organisation.

The Redland City Choir is managed by a committee which works closely with the Artistic Director to ensure the best outcome we can achieve for the choir.

Attendance

- Regular attendance at rehearsal is expected. To participate in performances, choristers are expected to attend at least 70% of rehearsals. Where possible, email the Redland City Choir if unwell or unable to attend.
- All choristers are to sign in as this is a safety requirement of the rehearsal venue.
- Choristers who are included in various ensembles are expected to join with the whole choir for regular rehearsals.

Punctuality and Preparation

- Choristers are expected to arrive on time and be ready to start rehearsal with the required music in order.
- All choristers are to do their best to learn the lyrics and music. Learning at home with rehearsal tracks where provided is important.

Behaviour

- Choristers are expected to be attentive during rehearsal and follow the directions of the director.
- Talking during rehearsal is considered inappropriate as this distracts the conductor and other choristers.
- All choristers are expected to treat each other including leaders and the extended choir community with dignity and respect. Bullying and harassment, including criticism of fellow choristers, whether physical, verbal, emotional or sexual are not tolerated.
- Choristers are expected to treat all rehearsal and performance venues with care and respect.
- Posting choir photos on any form of communication is not permitted without the permission of the Committee. The choir has an official website and Facebook account. All members are expected to respect individual privacy.
- Intoxication of any kind is not allowed at rehearsals and performances.

Performance Dress code

- Choristers are expected to abide by the style of dress/uniform as directed for various performances.

If you are the subject of inappropriate behaviour from someone during a rehearsal or event you should report this to the director or a committee member at your earliest convenience.

The Redland City Choir Incorporated reserves the right to exclude any person from participation in the choir for breach of the Code of Conduct.
