The Redland City Choir is a welcoming and diverse community where every voice matters. We value enthusiasm, kindness, and a shared commitment to making beautiful music together. By being part of the choir, each member helps uphold the high standards and positive reputation of our organisation. The choir is guided by a dedicated committee working closely with the Artistic Director to support the best possible experience for all choristers. Attendance

- Regular rehearsal attendance helps the choir sound its best. To take part in performances, members are expected to attend at least **70%** of rehearsals.
- If you're unwell or unable to attend, please email the choir when possible.
- Everyone must **sign in** at each rehearsal as part of the venue's safety requirements.
- Members who sing in smaller ensembles are also expected to attend full choir rehearsals as required, unless an exemption is approved by the Artistic Director and Committee.

Copyright & Privacy

- Upholding copyright laws is essential without exception. Members are not to copy music without permission from the Artistic Director. Rehearsal files stored on the member's portal are strictly for members only as an aid to learning the pieces.
- The member portal on the website is password protected. This is never to be shared with non-members.
- Personal details as provided on the signed membership form are stored confidentially for administrative purposes. These are not shared with anyone without consent to do so.
- Photos of the choir must not be posted online or shared publicly without Committee approval. The choir maintains an official website and Facebook page, and we ask all members to respect each other's privacy.

Punctuality & Preparation

- Please arrive on time and be ready to begin with your music organised and a 2B pencil.
- Learning lyrics and music is a shared responsibility. Rehearsing at home especially using rehearsal tracks when provided helps the whole choir shine.

Behaviour & Respect

- During rehearsals, please stay attentive and follow the director's guidance.
- Side conversations can be distracting for others, so we ask that talking be kept to a minimum.
- Every member of our choir community deserves dignity and respect. Bullying, harassment, or criticism of others whether physical, verbal, emotional, or sexual will not be tolerated.
- Please treat all rehearsal and performance venues with care.
- Intoxication of any kind is not allowed at rehearsals and performances.

Performance Dress Code

- Choristers are expected to follow the dress or uniform guidelines provided for each performance to present a unified and professional appearance.

If Something Isn't Right

If you experience or witness inappropriate behaviour at a rehearsal or event, please speak with the Artistic Director or a committee member as soon as you can. Your wellbeing matters.
